

Chemical Waste Management Guilty of Major Violation

It was reported in the Buffalo News on April 1 that Chemical Waste Management dug almost three hundred 12-foot holes in land where they want to build a new land fill.

They proceeded without approval from regulators and didn't follow existing rules, according to the Department of Environmental Conservation.

CWM also acted without notifying the state Health Department, which recently issued a new set of rules for testing after CWM had ignored, for decades, a ban on disturbing soil on their site. CWM was required to notify the Health Department, but they did not.
