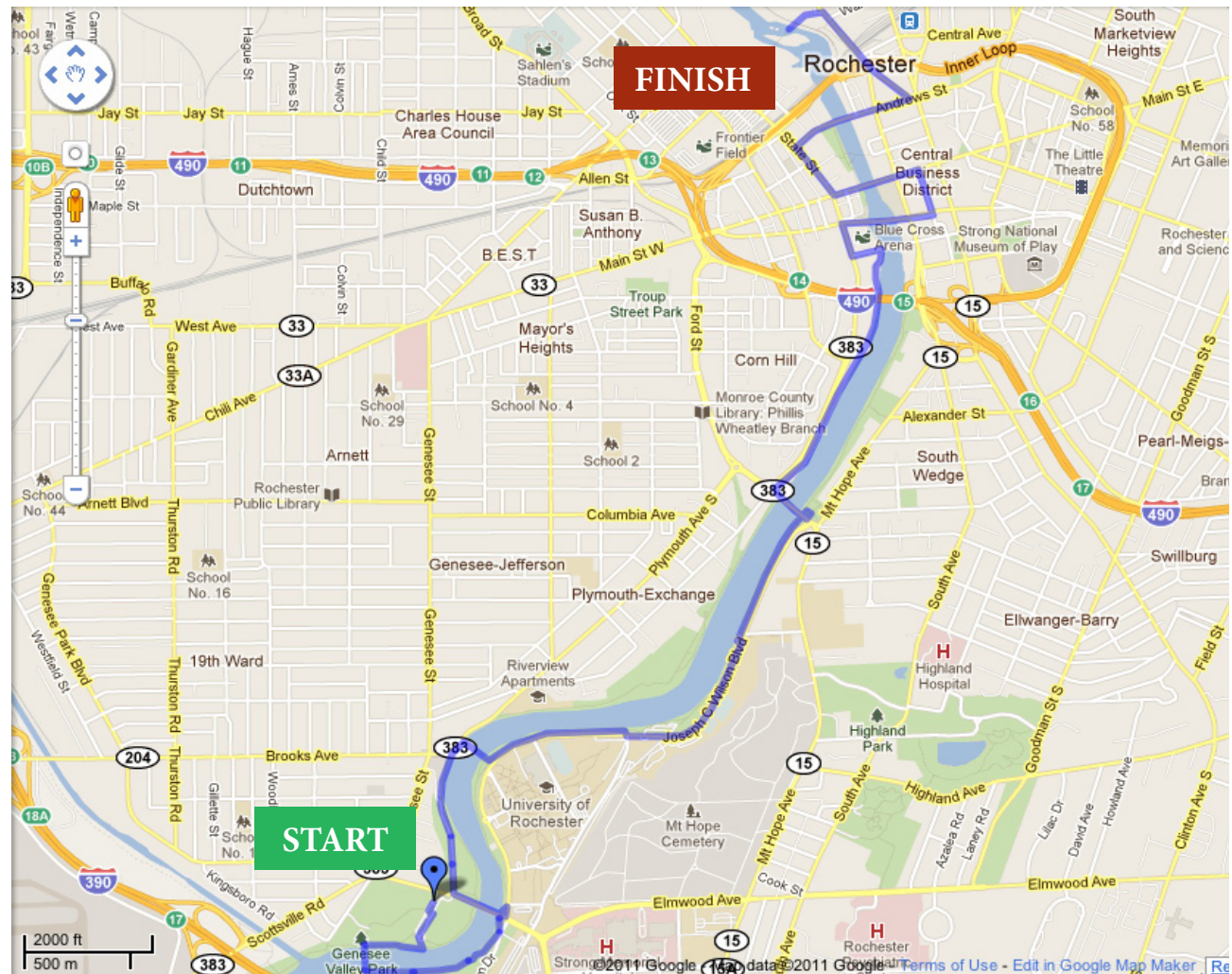
## Moving Planet

## Self-Guided Bike Ride (ride at own risk)

Start: Genesee Valley Park (GVP) Sports Complex, parking lot by pool 131 Elmwood Ave.  
South: Straight exit parking lot then veer left onto Genesee River Trail  
Left: cross river on pedestrian bridge to east side of GVP  
Left: Genesee Riverway Trail (GRT) go under Elmwood bridge  
Right & Right: onto north sidewalk of Elmwood Ave. Bridge  
Right: GRT  
Right: cross on pedestrian bridge to east side Genesee River  
Left: GRT to detour on Wilson Blvd then return to GRT and under Ford Street Bridge  
Right & Right: onto north sidewalk of Ford St. Bridge  
Right: GRT and go under Anthony/Douglas Bridge  
Exit: GRT at Court St.

Left: Court Street  
Right: Exchange Blvd.  
Right: Broad St. Bridge  
Cross: St. Paul St.  
Left: Stone St.  
Left: Main St.  
Cross: St. Paul St.  
Right: State St.  
Right: Andrews St. Bridge  
Cross: St. Paul St.  
Left: Bittner St.  
Merge: St. Paul St. and go under Railroad Bridge  
Left: Cataract St.  
Straight: Finish at Greentopia at High Falls!
